There are two types of scholarships available: the **Conference Merit Award** and the **McMurray Award**. The **Conference Merit Award** must be given to a Florida United Methodist student who plans to attend or attends a United Methodist related college, university or seminary. The **McMurray Award** may be given to a Florida United Methodist student who plans to attend or attends any institution of higher education.

### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Local United Methodist churches are invited to nominate one student (no more) for the Board of Higher Education & Campus Ministry Annual Scholarships.

There are now two scholarship sources that are available through the Florida Conference Board of Higher Education & Campus Ministry.

One is the <u>Merit Scholarship</u> fund obtained through the Student Day offerings taken each year on the Sunday following Thanksgiving. These funds must be given to a fulltime student planning to attend an institution of higher education recognized as United Methodist by the University Senate of the United Methodist Church.

The other is a <u>**Private Scholarship**</u> fund that can be given to a student, who is a member of a Florida Conference United Methodist congregation, attending any college or university. The student must meet the criteria given below.

### **APPLICANTS MUST:**

- 1. Be an active full-time member of a local United Methodist Church for at least one year prior to the date of application.
- 2. Be nominated by a local church through its pastor or the chairperson of Higher Education & Campus Ministry
- 3. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. Incoming freshman must have a grade average of B (3.0) or better at the end of the next to the last semester in high school. Students already attending college must have a grade average of B (3.0) or better for the year preceding the award.
- 4. Demonstrate commitment to the local church and an interest in serving others in the community.
- 5. Demonstrate financial need.
- 6. Be a US citizen.
